

## **The Book of Proverbs**

Men, what do you really value? What is your greatest asset? Is our relationship with God at the top of the list? Do we prefer His discipline over chasing money? Do we value His wisdom and knowledge over a lucrative career? We can only pursue one main thing in life, what is that going to be? (Mt. 6:33) Proverbs chapter 8 suggests wisdom should be one of our prized assets in life - 8:35. Read chapter 8 over a few times. How would you outline this chapter?



We must come *pre-committed* to humbly obey whatever Wisdom says. With that pre-condition we will find wisdom and in finding wisdom we will find life, and obtain favor from the Lord -8:35.



"A chapter which is to soar beyond time and space, opens at street-level, to make it clear, first, that the wisdom of God is as relevant to the shopping-center (2,3) as to heaven itself (22); second, that it is available to the veriest dunce (5; cf. 1:20-33, especially 22); third, that it is active in seeking us – so that our own search, earnest as it has to be (17, 34), is a response, not an uncertain quest..."
