

## The Book of Proverbs

Men, you don't have to hate Jesus to ruin your life, you just have to be ok with who you are. Proverbs continually confronts us with the problem of staying as we are (an impossibility -we always digress) or growing into who God expects us to be.

After the goal of the book (1:1-6) and the theme of the book (1:7) is presented we are immediately confronted with "The Counsel of a Father" -1:8-19 and the –"Call of Wisdom" 1:20-33. Imperative in both is a willingness to hear and to listen. Men who do you listen to?
