Study #1



God has a lot to say about David. In fact, there are more chapters in God's word dedicated to David than another other man. Abraham, for instance, has fourteen chapters in God's word -as does Joseph. Jacob eleven. Elijah ten. God dedicates sixty-six chapters to David. Abraham was a friend of God and David -a man after God's own heart. This study will focus on the life of Davie as found in 1 Samuel 16 through 1 Kings 2.

Read 1 Samuel 15 & 16 making observations and taking notes about what God is showing you. Spend some time answering the following questions.
