Assurance of Salvation

Memory Verse: "And this is the testimony that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in the Son. He who has the Son has life; He who does not have the Son of God does not have life." -I John 5:11,12

God wants us to be sure we have forgiveness of sin and eternal life (a relationship with Him –Jn. 17:3). We can be sure because none of this depends on us. It isn't our performance, our good works, our religious routines, it isn't our anything! It's His everything! This study will help us trust God's word rather than our feelings for assurance of Salvation.

Every child of God is tempted to doubt their salvation. A nagging voice inside us will say things like..."you're not good enough!", "you don't think you're saved and your sins forgiven just because you believed in Jesus?". It'll accuse us and say things like..."Look you sinned, you can't be saved!"

The key to successfully resisting these attacks is to rely on what God says rather than what we think or feel.

How to Memorize a Verse

Our relationship with God is driven by truth -by the fact of His word not our feelings. So you will want to memorize truth. Truth will set you free from many of the lies you believe. The following are some simple guidelines for memorizing a verse.

1. Before you start to memorize read it out loud a number of times.

2. Learn the topic, reference, and first phrase as a unit. For instance for this verse is would be "Assurance of Salvation" (topic), 1 John 5:11&12 (reference), "And this is the testimony..." (first phrase).

3. After you have reviewed the topic, reference, and first phrase a few times, add the second phrase. Gradually add phrases until you know the whole verse.

4. Work on the verse audibly whenever possible.

5. As you memorize and review think about how it applies to your life.


6. The most critical element is review, review, review! Write the verse on a 5x7 card or something you can keep handy as you review. The more you review the greater your retention.


